

In order to put together a meaningful, safe and fun program we need to know your interest in participating in a UCC Family Camp.

When reviewing the information below, it will be important to be thinking of your family group. Consider those folks that are currently in your bubble that will be sharing your housing and dining spaces with you. This will be your Family Group at Camp.

What is a Family Group?

A Family Group is whatever you decide a family is as long as they are currently residing together and/or have been a part of your "bubble" for more than 2 weeks. This is the group you will be sharing a table with in the dining hall, a cabin or lodge room with and hanging out with mostly.

What do I need to do prior to camp?

All those able to receive a vaccine must do so. Others able to get tested must do so and receive a negative test 1-3 days prior to arriving at N-Sid-Sen.

In addition, all folks are asked to self-monitor their outside activities 14 days prior to camp. This can include:

Taking and recording daily temperature checks.

Self-screening for COVID-19 like symptoms. We will send out a suggested checklist.

Not traveling out of the country.

No close contact with known COVID-19 positive persons.

While traveling to N-Sid-Sen please make only the stops necessary for fuel and bio breaks. You will receive via email all the regular forms and a health check list related to Covid-19. You will receive a check in time to arrive at camp. Please plan on arriving on time.

What can I expect upon arriving at camp?

Arrive on time for your welcome to camp. All campers will be temperature checked upon arriving while in their cars. Temperature checks will be happening daily at breakfast times. In your car you will then travel to the nurse where they will meet with families in an outside tented area. Campers will then be able to drive as close as possible to their lodgings where they will find any further information.

How will camp be different?

Because it will be shorter we will not be floating the river this year. Your directors are planning on using the wide open spaces at N-Sid-Sen for bigger games for all. Look for opportunities to greet other family groups from a distance as well as share in big games and activities. Outdoor dining will be the norm for most meals. Family groups will arrive at meals in preset times allowing for safe flow for all. We will be setting and wiping tables. Do not worry, you will still get to sweep the floors. We will have revolving opportunities all around camp so that family groups will have plenty of space to enjoy all that N-Sid-Sen has to offer.

How will housing work?

We are still working out the details, which is why the attached poll is so important. Family groups will be assigned a bathroom/shower for their private use. Cabins will be exclusive use of a family group. Lodge rooms will be assigned a bathroom as well. N-Sid-Sen staff will be cleaning shared bathrooms more often than normal.

Will there be times when I can gather with others?

Your team is working on creative plans on outdoor amphitheater style worship, large circle connections, and big games.

Can I visit with other family groups?

Yes, while wearing masks and social distancing you will be able to visit with others remembering to limit the amount of time and number of folks involved. Meeting on porches may need to become connecting in the many fields, meadows and beaches instead.

What is the cost?

Adults = \$325 / Youth 8-12 = \$300 /Child 3-7 = \$275

As usual gratitude rates are available. Adults = \$425 / Youth 8-12 = \$400

Child 3-7 = \$375
