Camp is rough on clothes and gear. Items that are older and less expensive are recommended. Please send a STURDY WATER BOTTLE with your camper or purchase one at N-Sid-Sen.

> To avoid injuries to feet and ankles, we ask everyone to wear sturdy shoes. This also makes walking and hiking safer and more enjoyable. PLEASE LEAVE WEDGE/PLATFORM & FLIMSY SHOES AT HOME!

Clothing should be appropriate for a church camp - without words or graphics that could be interpreted as hurtful or disrespectful by individuals from a wide variety of ages and backgrounds.
