CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT LIST - Full Week Youth Sessions

Camp is rough on clothes and gear. Items that are older and less expensive are recommended.

Please send a STURDY WATER BOTTLE with your camper or purchase one at N-Sid-Sen.

To avoid injuries to feet and ankles, we ask everyone to wear sturdy shoes with **closed toes** - except at designated times and places. This also makes walking and hiking safer and more enjoyable.

PLEASE LEAVE WEDGE/PLATFORM & FLIMSY SHOES AT HOME!

Clothing should be appropriate for a church camp - without words or graphics that could be interpreted as hurtful or disrespectful by individuals from a wide variety of ages and backgrounds.

CLOTHING - in addition to what camper wears to camp

7 pairs of shorts or capris 2 swimsuits

1 pair of lightweight long pants*
 2nd pair of sturdy, lightweight shoes for walking & hiking
 1 pair of water shoes (great for swimming & boating)

8 t-shirts 1-2 sweatshirts or fleece jackets

7 sets of underwear 1 rain jacket or poncho

7 pairs of socks 2 pairs of light-weight pajamas

NOTE: Clothes often get dirty or wet, so extras are needed. Please pack **AT LEAST** the number of items indicated.

BEDDING

Option 1: • sleeping bag • pillow and pillowcase • optional - fitted & top sheet for warm nights (Sleeping bags should be rolled tightly and secured with a sturdy tie or belt. Stuff bags also work well!)

Option 2: • fitted twin sheet • flat sheet • blanket • pillow and pillowcase

ALSO NEEDED

water bottle - sturdy

2 bath towels & 2 washcloths

2 beach towels

3 beach towels

4 wash kit (toothpaste/brush, soap, shampoo, deodorant...)

2 bath towels & 2 washcloths

6 in original container

7 a hat to keep the sun & bugs off your head

8 wash kit (toothpaste/brush, soap, shampoo, deodorant...)

8 shower/bathroom shoes

9 repellent for insects – NO AEROSOL CANS PLEASE – lotion, wipes or pump spray are acceptable

OPTIONAL

flashlight or headlamp & extra batteries pencil/pen, paper, stamped envelopes small fan & extension cord musical instrument - guitar, banjo, ukulele, recorder, etc.

DO NOT BRING:

- ⇒ valuable or breakable items ⇒ aerosol products of any kind ⇒ electronic devices of any kind
- ⇒ cell/smart phones ⇒ tablets, media players, electronic games, etc. ⇒ cameras of any kind
- ⇒ laser pointers
 ⇒ flimsy or wedge/platform shoes
 ⇒ fireworks
 ⇒ matches or lighters
- ⇒ guns, knives, or any type of weapon ⇒ candy, gum, soda, food items ⇒ radios
- ⇒ items containing alcohol, cannabis, or tobacco products ⇒ vapes ⇒ any illegal substances
